# **ANNOUNCEMENT**



## 1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The competition “N.A.Panin-Kolomenkin Memorial” will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2010, the Special Regulations for Single & Pair Skating 2010, the Special Regulations for Ice Dance 2010, the Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2010 and the Technical Rules Ice Dance 2010 as well as all pertinent ISU Communications.

Participation in the competition “N.A.Panin-Kolomenkin Memorial” is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 2. b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 1420.

Categories of competitors:

- Men, Seniors – 1997 y.b. and older
- Men, Juniors – 2000 y.b. and older
- Ladies, Seniors – 1997 y.b. and older
- Ladies, Juniors – 2000 y.b. and older
- Pairs, Seniors, Juniors
- Ice Dance, Juniors and Advanced Novice.

## 2. DATES AND PLACE

Open competition “N.A.Panin-Kolomenkin Memorial” will be conducted at the main arena of St.Petersburg Figure Skating School on December, 13-16, 2011. The ice rink is 60m x 30m. The address of School: Tupolevskaya 4 (subway station “Komendantskiy prospekt”), St.Petersburg.

The draw and Opening ceremony will be conducted on December, 13.

## 3. ORGANIZING COMMITTEE

Competition management is conducted by **St.Petersburg Figure Skating Federation** in cooperation with **Physical Culture and Sports Committee of St.Petersburg**.

#### **4. SAFETY ASSURANCE AND LIABILITY**

The competition will be held at the sport arena meeting the requirements of Regulatory legal acts of Russian Federation.

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the N.A.Panin-Kolomenkin Memorial to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

The OC assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or for property lost or damage incurred by any Competitors or any kind of Officials.

#### **5. ENTRIES**

Preliminary entries as standard application form should be sent by the organization (or federation) representing athletes until the 1<sup>st</sup> of December, 2011.

Personal entries and medical insurance to the competition are handed in to the Organizing Committee until 11 AM on 13<sup>th</sup> of December, 2011.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit the number of participants in each type of program during the procedure of application consideration:

- Men Seniors – 12 participants
- Men Juniors – 24 participants
- Ladies Seniors – 12 participants
- Ladies Juniors – 24 participants
- Pairs Seniors – 8 pairs
- Pairs Juniors – 12 pairs
- Ice Dance Juniors – 15 dance pairs
- Ice Dance Advanced Novice – 15 dance pairs

The application forms must be sent to the OC.

#### **6. MUSIC**

All competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on CD format, in accordance with Rules 343, paragraph 1. Music for each program (Short Program/Free Skating, Short Dance/Free Dance) must be recorded on a separate disc. Discs must show the competition event, competitor's name, nation and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal, and must be submitted at the time of registration.



Disks have to be provided to the OC before the draws.

## **7. EXHIBITION AND AWARDS**

The best three places skaters/couples in the final ranking of each category will be invited to take part in an exhibition on 16<sup>th</sup> of December.

The three best placed in each category will be awarded with Cups, medals, diplomas and flowers. The winners' coaches and choreographers will be awarded with diplomas and flowers.

## **8. MEDICAL CARE**

First aid is delivered by the physician of the competitions.

Each competitor is obliged to have the medical insurance and to hand it to the Mandatory Committee.

## **9. FEES AND EXPENSES**

No entry fee is required to pay by competitors.

All the expenses of competition organization (salaries for judges, physicians and staff, cups, souvenirs etc.) are covered by St.Petersburg budget.

All competitors, coaches and team leaders have to cover their own expenses.
